Public Consultation into the Future of the Brandt Centre enters Phase Two

Regina, Saskatchewan – The Regina Exhibition Association Limited (REAL) has launched phase two of public consultation into the future of the Brandt Centre at the REAL District, upon completing the first round of consultation in January and February.

Over the course of four weeks, REAL invited the public to fill out an online survey about their experience with the Brandt Centre. More than 5,300 responses were received. Some key highlights include:

- 84% of respondents were Regina residents
- 75% of respondents feel the Brandt Centre is a 'Very Important' asset to the City of Regina
- 76% of respondents attend sporting events at the Brandt Centre
- 41% of respondents were 'satisfied' with their experience visiting the Brandt Centre
- The average experience rating from respondents was 3/5

"We want to thank everyone who participated in the first round of consultation," said Tim Reid, President, and CEO of REAL. "The information gathered will help us understand what role the Brandt Centre plays in our community, and in turn, plan for the future of the facility."

As part of phase two, the public is invited to fill out a second, more detailed online survey that will focus on the next steps for the Brandt Centre, as well as development and funding options.

"The response to the first phase of the survey was incredible," said Tiffany Stephenson, Arena Planning Strategy Committee (APSC) Co-chair. "We're excited for phase two of the survey to really dig deeper into the public's thoughts and opinions on what a reimagined Brandt Centre could look like."

The results of the second public survey will be released in April. REAL will prepare and submit a final report with our recommendations to Regina City Council in June.
