A returning favourite to the Fair is **RIDER DAY** on Sunday, August 6. All game day ticket holders are admitted into the fair for FREE. Concert times have also been adjusted to allow for entertainment before and after the game. Watch the Riders take on the Ottawa Redblacks and come early and stay late for a corn dog and Ferris Wheel ride!

The QCX Midway brought to you by North American Midway Entertainment is full of fun and thrills this year, with over 50 rides to entertain everyone young and old. New rides for 2023 include **X Drive, Wave Swinger, and Outlaw Roller Coaster** and for the Kids, **Elephants and Teacups**. Each night at 8:30 will also see the **Jelly Fish Parade** right on the Midway.

For the 19+ crowd, we will have the **Original 16 Midway Beer Garden** with musical performances from Dangerous Cheese and Karaoke with DJ Zubazz.

Pile O Bones Rodeo presented by C5 Rodeo, CWA and CKRM is back again on Friday and Saturday at 6:30pm in the Brandt Centre. Last year the crowd was energized by the talent in the ring. As always, the Rodeo is included in your gate admission but get to the Brandt Centre early as it is rush seating. Miss Rodeo Canada, Mackenzie Skeels, will be on hand before the nightly event. This is a PRCA sanctioned event with award-winning competitors such as Kyle Lucas, Michael Otero and Curtis Cassidy.

The Brandt Centre is also home to the Stock Dog Demonstrations, which are new to the Fair on August 2, 3 and 6th.

One of the QCX highlights is the food! New food items to enjoy include: Cotton Candy light Saber, Frosty Pink Lemonade Ice Cream, Extreme Zeus Poutine and the Peanut Butter Pickle Dog—just to name a few! Fan Favourite, and last year's best food vendor winner, Beaver Tails is back, as is our Prairie Stack, featuring perogies and sausage on a stick. Our Best in Food Competition returns with your chance to weigh in on your favourite fair food on our Instagram stories. Just follow @queencityex. Voting begins every day at 12 p.m. The vendor with the most votes will be crowned QCX 2023 Best in Food on the final day of the exhibition. This year look for the Best in Food stickers and be sure to try them all!

Also returning is **Queen City Mustard**. Our own Chef Chaminda has created 2 new mustards that will Turn Up the Flavour- *Sun Dried Tomato Mustard* and *Whole Grain Beer Mustard*. Your corn dog will never taste better. Check out the taste testing on Saturday in Confederation Park.

The SaskTel Extreme Zone is heating up outside with Global Pet Foods Super Dogs, Ride the Vibe, Snow Circus, Canadian Armed Forces Activation, Sponsor Activations and more. Showtimes run throughout the day between 1 – 8 p.m.

Family shows run every day from 1-7 p.m. inside the Viterra International Trade Centre These shows include the ever-popular **Bluey**, **Canine Circus**, and **Silly Science with Professor Dillon**. Bluey will be available for a meet & greet after each show daily for \$10 per child. This is sure to sell out so advance bookings are encouraged. It will feature educational teachings and daily performances from Noon – 8 p.m. daily.

Our organizations are joining forces to raise 200,000 meals!
